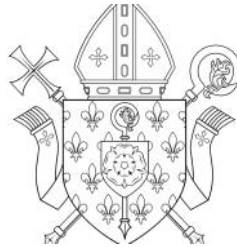

£25.00	Roll of concrete area or tin of paint
£50.00	Flooring per square metre
£100.00	Stone window head or plastic manhole
£150.00	Nappy/baby changing unit or manhole cover
£250.00	uPVC window or WC or electrical heater or hand drier
